CLUB RULES (From By-Laws)

Production 20/20

- (1) Each two (2) driver team shall be allocated to one car only.
- (2) Each driver shall complete two heats, in any order as decided between the two team drivers.
- (3) The starting grid for the Production 20/20 feature race will be in order with pole position allocated to the highest total point scorer over all heat races, through to the lowest point scorer over all heat races allocated the last position.
- (4) Team Drivers will decide the order in which they race in the feature.
- (5) At the end of twenty (20) laps, the yellow light will be applied. Cars will then be re-gridded in the order in which they crossed the start/finish line.
- (6) The restart will be in an Indian file format.
- (7) Lapped cars will be lined up according to their position at the end of the first twenty laps. For example: if you cross the line third, you will start from the third starting position in the restart.
